Subject: Counselling and spot admission against seats remaining vacant in the Post Graduate programmes

Consequent upon the completion of the admission of the candidates selected in the first list, seats remain vacant in the Post Graduate programmes. In order to fill the said vacancies, counselling followed by spot admission shall be conducted at the College Campus NBBGC Tadong on 24 August 2026 (Monday).

Candidates who did not apply during the application window from 04 to 13 August 2026 are eligible to participate in the counselling. No separate entrance examination shall be held.

Interested candidates must report in person at the Admission Desk at NBBGC Tadong Campus, on 24 August 2026, with the duly filled application form and all the requisite documents in original along with one set of self-attested photocopies. The list of requisite documents is given at Annexure I to this notice. The application form may be downloaded from www.nbbgc.org.

1:30 PM onwards	Counselling, verification of original documents and allotment of seats in order of merit
Up to 300 PM	Payment of fees and completion of admission formalities

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE COUNSELLING

- 1. Registration will close at 12:00 Noon. No candidate reporting after the closing time shall be registered, irrespective of the reason.**
2. Where the number of eligible candidates for a programme exceeds the number of seats vacant therein, seats shall be allotted strictly in order of merit, determined based on the aggregate percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying undergraduate examination.

3. In the event of a tie, preference shall be given in the following order: (i) higher percentage of marks in the concerned subject at the undergraduate level.
4. **A candidate must have completed the undergraduate programme in the relevant discipline or its equivalent, and must satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed by Sikkim University for the programme concerned.**
5. Candidates who were selected earlier but failed to report for admission on 17 August 2026 may participate in the counselling; however, they shall enjoy no preferential claim over other candidates and shall be considered strictly on merit along with all others.
6. Admission shall be completed on the same day. A candidate allotted a seat who fails to pay the prescribed fee within the stipulated hours shall forfeit the allotment, and the seat shall be offered to the next candidate in order of merit.
7. Admission is provisional and subject to completion of registration to Sikkim University. Any admission secured based on incorrect, incomplete or false information shall be cancelled at any stage, and the fees paid shall stand forfeited.
8. **Participation in the counselling confers no right to admission. The decision of the Admission Committee of the College in all matters relating to the counselling and allotment of seats shall be final and binding.**

ANNEXURE I

LIST OF REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

Every candidate attending the counselling on 24 August 2026 shall bring the following documents in original, together with one set of self-attested photocopies:

1. Duly filled application form for PG Admission 2026, along with the prescribed application fee in Cash.
2. Class X Admit Card / Certificate (as proof of date of birth).
3. Class X Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate.
4. Class XII Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate.
5. Mark Sheets of all semesters/years of the qualifying undergraduate programme.
6. Provisional Certificate / Degree Certificate of the qualifying undergraduate programme.
7. Transfer Certificate / College Leaving Certificate from the institution last attended.
8. Character Certificate from the institution last attended.
9. Certificate of Identification (COI) / Sikkim Subject Certificate, duly attested by the relevant authority.
10. Category Certificate (SC / ST / OBC / PwD / EWS), wherever applicable.
11. Aadhaar Card (photocopy, self-attested).
